- Neonatal stage (the first three weeks),
- Infancy (one to twelve months),
- Childhood and Juvenile (2 to 14 years),
- Adolescence stage (15 - 24 years),
- Adulthood (25 - 60 years) and
- Old Age / Geriatric (61 and above)

Symptoms of a physical disease/injury/handicap at one stage can impact an individual in all subsequent stages along the HLC.
